Home Access Center (HAC)

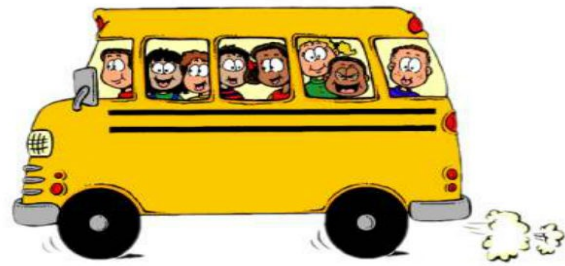
HAC is a web-based application that is part of our student information system called eSchoolPlus.

Features and Benefits:

- Provides parents and students with a daily summary page of student information including:
 - ◊ Schedule and attendance, discipline information, class work, and test scores
- Allows students to view their own records in the system to help keep them informed about their progress
- Engages parents via an Internet parental portal, connecting them with the classroom and providing them with relevant and timely information to support/direct their children
