SUGGESTED ITINERARY

SUNDAY
JANUARY 20

6:30 PM

Meet with your group and check in with your chaperones at Fruit Cove Middle School.

7:15 PM

Depart St. Johns, FL via chartered motor coach enroute to Washington, D.C. (necessary stops made for breaks)

MONDAY
JANUARY 21

8:00 AM

Approximately, breakfast at your hotel. This morning you will visit the National Archives Building (10:00 AM). Afterwards go to the nation's Capitol Building where you will have lunch in the Capitol Cafeteria, tour the Capitol Building (subject to appointment) and the Library of Congress. You will also have a group photo on the Capitol steps.

4:30 PM

Check into your hotel. Depart hotel for dinner at Hard Rock Cafe, then return to your hotel.

TUESDAY
JANUARY 22

6:30 AM

Breakfast. This morning you will travel to Gettysburg, PA where you will visit the Visitor Center for a short film, the cyclorama and the galleries, time permitting. Afterwards tour the Battlefield making stops at the Virginia Memorial and Little Round Top (weather permitting). Lunch @ Dobbins House. Depart for Lancaster, PA where you will tour the farmlands, visit an Amish home (reproduction) and a one room school house. Dinner, afterwards return to Washington, D.C.

WEDNESDAY
JANUARY 23

6:30 AM

Breakfast. This morning you will afternoon you will visit Arlington National Cemetery where you will see President Kennedy's gravesite, view the Changing of the Guard at the tomb of the Unknown Soldier and participate in a wreath laying ceremony at the Tomb (arranged by group). Lunch. This afternoon you will visit the 9/11 Memorial and the Holocaust Museum (subject to appointment).

5:30 PM

Arrive back at your hotel to change for your dinner dance cruise on the Potomac

7:00 PM

Dinner dance cruise (subject to weather conditions). Afterwards return to your hotel.

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THURSDAY
JANUARY 24

7:00 AM

Breakfast, then check out of your hotel. Visit Ford's Theatre (9:00 AM) and the Educational Center (subject to appointment), then visit the Washington National Cathedral (subject to appointment). Lunch at the American History Museum and time to explore the exhibits. Afterwards visit the African American History and Cultural Museum (subject to ticket availability) and the Lincoln, Viet Nam, Korean, FDR, MLK, Jefferson and World War II Memorials, as well as a picture stop at the White House. Dinner, then begin your trip home.

FRIDAY
JANUARY 25

9:00 AM

Approximately, arrive St. Johns, FL.
