The dance was sold out with over 400 students that participated. PTO organized the dance which hosted games, food, drinks, and music for the students. Mrs. Jacobson also reported that FCM's clubs have been kicking off this month and clubs are sponsored by teachers. It was mentioned that clubs provide an opportunity for students to connect with each other beyond the classroom. Clubs include: B6 (six pillars of character), FFEA (Florida Future Educators of America), Art, Chess, FCA(Fellowship of Christian Athletes), Marine Science, Minecraft, and Sunshine State Young Readers Award Club. Mrs. Carroll was recognized for the winner of last year's award for FFEA. Mrs. Jacobson reported that parent night was changed this year due to the feedback from parents and teachers will be posting their presentations on Schoology. For upcoming news, Mrs. Jacobson reported that yearbooks are on sale and pre-purchasing is available because yearbooks can sale out. FCM's first volleyball game of the season will be held on 9/19/23 and the first home game is 9/26/23. PTO will meet on 9/26/23 and this month's speaker will focus on social media which will take
