The SRF will be released in the upcoming check for teachers. The SRF and SAC funding rolls over to next year, no matter if the funds are spent or not. Staff, administration, and faculty will vote on how the funding is used. SAC is currently getting money at this current time from the leftover Teacher Lead money and SRF funding. SRF is distributed each winter of the following school year. Planning will begin in January for the SRF funds.

### **Principal's Update- A. Hensley**

- Ms. Hensley wanted to thank everyone for being here. An update on the attendance issues from the last meeting was discussed. There have been positive updates with phone calls and parent meetings to help those students. Six students from FCMS have made it to the county STEM fair. We also have a student who will represent the county in the spelling bee. WEB has been recognized for the Purple Star Award, and we will be receiving recognition for this award this evening. We are on the 12 days before winter break and are doing a great job keeping the spirits up before leaving for winter break. IN January, the Superintendent will have a WEB X, which will provide a lot of information regarding the budget and legislative updates, specifically regarding public schools.
