Call to order: We do not have a quorum physically present, so no voting will take place.

Old Business- T. Carroll- SAC funds balance (No Change)

- SRF: \$8,472.21 No changes
- SAC: \$266.41- No changes

New Business- T. Carroll

- T. Carroll welcomed everyone to the meeting and presented today's agenda. T. Carroll discussed the SRF ballot that will be sent out soon. Teachers will find out about the ballot and the change in the ballot. Last month's minutes and April's minutes will be approved at the May meeting in person. The SAC family survey will be reviewed, and the future SAC meetings for the 2026-2027 school year will be held less frequently for the upcoming school year. Meetings will take place when things need to be approved and will be quarterly. Of the 1200 students that we have at FCMS, there were only 16 parent responses for the family survey. The survey was open for 53 days. 56% of the individuals surveyed showed that high-quality education is being

provided at FCMS. School safety was surveyed as showing that FCMS is a safe school. 75% of the parents surveyed said that communication is excellent. 69% surveyed said their child feels cared for. WEB and character counts are a strength at FCMS. A suggestion for the parent survey participation is to have a QR code provided at parent pick-up, where families can complete it while waiting in line.

- **Principal's Update- A. Hensley**

Ms. Hensley updated the committee on the school survey for families. 50% of teachers provided feedback. Overall, positive feedback was received from the teacher surveys. We had another band performance with superior ratings, especially with the help of the band intern. Writing testing finished this month. Testing will continue in May. The spring dance took place, and about 250 kids attended. Teacher Appreciation Week will take place at the end of the month. Important events in May include 8th-grade awards and Gradventure. Theatre will have the school play next week.
