**New Business- T. Carroll**

- T. Carroll welcomed everyone to the meeting and presented today's agenda. T. Carroll made a motion to vote for our new member, Kelly Anderson, into SAC. Fabiola Bonnet will second the motion. T. Carroll updated everyone on the updates from the school district on how SAC runs and how it functions. We need to be present to vote. To vote, we must have a physical quorum present to vote for the vote to count. T. Carroll is asking if the time to meet for our SAC meeting is at 2 pm. We will officially vote to change the time from 2:30 to 2:00 pm. T. Carroll makes a motion to change the time from 2:30 to 2 pm for the remaining SAC meetings. J. Chen seconds the motion. A new invite will be sent out with the new SAC meeting times.

- Everything to date is approved. T. Carroll would like to make a motion to approve all previous meeting minutes and voting. M. McCarthy seconded the motion to approve the minutes. T. Carroll discussed that the remaining lead money, which remains unspent, will go back into the SAC account. As a SAC committee, we will create a ballot for SRF. We can decide how the SRF will be used with this ballot. Mr. Chen made a motion to approve the December and January minutes. K. Anderson seconded the motion.  
T. Carroll discussed that Google Forms will be sent out as the new parent survey. The window will close at the end of March, and will be blasted out on Parent Square, newsletter, and online. SAC will be able to look at all the school survey data. Our next meeting will be on March 10<sup>th</sup>.

- **Principal's Update- A. Hensley**

Ms. Hensley updated us that the future budget will not be available until the end of March. This will help with planning for next year. SAC money does look like it will be going away. Teachers may not know that we are losing that funding if not involved in SAC. PM2 testing is finished, and all scores increased across the board for 6-8 grades. Six of our students made it to the STEM fair. WEB is hosting the Valentine's Day party for our students. Basketball season is halfway through the season, and 8th-grade night is taking place on February 26<sup>th</sup>. Battle of the Books is taking place. The eighth-grade semi-formal dance took place, and it was a huge success. PTO did a fabulous job! There was huge support from faculty and staff at the dance. Tickets are on sale for Gradventure, which will take place in May. Our eighth-grade group is one of our largest groups to have come through. Official projections are not ready yet for the upcoming school year, so hopefully, we will not have any impact on student numbers. Our rising 7th-grade parent meeting is tonight, and our rising 6th-grade meeting is next Tuesday. Teachers are currently making recommendations for students. Dates will be posted on the website. Parents will see what the teachers are recommended for and will be able to see this on paper and on HAC. 8th-grade students will be meeting with the counselors in the media center. Students will be able to call their parents with their guidance counselor during the scheduling meeting. FCMS and all High Schools in the county will put everything online if meetings are missed. Academy notifications are being sent out now and will continue to be sent out over the next few weeks.
