2022-2023 Sunshine State Young Readers Award Program

The SSYRA Program has begun! Interested students will be added to an SSYRA Course in Schoology <u>after</u> the <u>parent permission form</u> is returned. Registration is ongoing until December 2, 2022. Students will read an SSYRA book and take a 25-point quiz on the book. They will have 2 attempts and must score over 60% (cumulative) to receive credit for the book. Successful quizzes are rewarded with a Schoology badge and a PBIS point. The program ends on March 9, 2023.
