The SSYRA Program has begun! Interested students will be added to an SSYRA Course in Schoology <u>after</u> the <u>parent permission form</u> is returned. They will have 2 attempts and must score over 60% (cumulative) to receive credit for the book. Successful quizzes are rewarded with a Schoology badge and a PBIS point. 


