
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

School Messenger allows legal guardian contacts of SJCSD students the ability to control how they receive non-emergency communications, either by Phone, Text, Email, or any combination of these methods.



This is where you can choose the way you receive Non-Emergency Messages (Phone, Text, Email)




5. To change a preference, click on the type of message



Select/Unselect inside each section to choose what content will be sent to what number/email.

Leave all selections in a section blank if you do not want to be contacted using that method (Example: leave Phone call section and Email section blank if you ONLY want to receive Text messages).



*Note: Text Messages will only be sent to numbers that have opted-in to the School Messenger system by texting "Y" to 67587.
