What is SAC?

- A council of parents, school faculty and staff, and other community and business members who meet to address the needs of the school, as related to the school improvement plan.
- A council of stakeholders who vote on expenditures to support the school improvement plan, such as items for PBIS and new computers that were approved and purchased last year.
- FCMS SAC meets once a month, on the second Tuesday of each month at 2:30pm.

What are the duties of the teacher, parent, business, and community representatives?

- Members act as a resource for SAC in the areas of community related issues that affect the school and its students.
- Members serve as a communications link between SAC, business, community, and parent groups.

2025-2026 Sunshine State Young Readers Award Program

The SSYRA Program has begun! Interested students will be added to an SSYRA Course in Schoology <u>after</u> the <u>parent permission form</u> is returned. **Registration is ongoing until December 1, 2025.** Students will read an SSYRA book and take a 25-point quiz on the book. They must score 60% or over to receive credit for the book. Successful quizzes are rewarded with a Schoology badge and a PBIS point. The program ends on Sunday, April 26, 2026.



2025-2026 Sunshine State Young Readers Award List

The Battle of the Books team will be determined by the quizzes completed by Sunday, January 19, 2026. The seven students with the most books read and the highest average quiz score will make up the team.

The District Battle will take place on Tuesday, March 24, 2026.

Calling all 7th and 8th Grade Adventurers!




